

2. The Judgment Seat of Christ

Romans 14:10-13, 2 Corinthians 5:9-11, 1 Corinthians 3:11-15

Judged for everything you have done after you were saved. Not to determine salvation, but to determine rewards. Works are tried to see of what sort it is. Give a mock trial. Takes place during the tribulation on earth.

3. The Marriage Supper of the Lamb

Revelation 19:7-9

The greatest wedding supper you will ever be to. This takes place after Jesus Christ marries his bride. Talk about the marriage. After the marriage ceremony is over, there we will sit with all the saved up through the rapture. I am guessing the angels will serve us our food.

4. The Day of the LORD

Revelation 19, Psalm 110, Zechariah 14, etc, etc, etc

We come back with Jesus Christ on horses (Joel 2) and fight alongside him. He slays millions and stomps on them with his feet and blood gets everywhere. Talk about this and what it will be like. After the battle Jesus goes and gets a drink of water from the brook and lifts up the head.

5. The Millennial Reign of Christ

Revelation 20
