Moses	Jesus
400 years of silence before God sent Moses to save Israel. (Genesis 15:13, Galatians 3:17)	400 years of silence before God sent Jesus to save the whole world (End of Malachi – birth of Christ)
Firstborn sons murdered, Moses escaped (Exodus 1)	Firstborn sons murdered, Jesus escaped (Matthew 2:1-18)
Made a god (Exodus 7:1), his brother his prophet	Is the God (1 Timothy 3:16), his cousin his prophet
Rejected by the Jews initially (Exodus 32:1)	Rejected by the Jews initially (John 1)
Knew God face to face (Exodus 33:11)	Knew God face to face (John 1:18)
Gave them bread from heaven (Exodus 16)	Gave them the true bread from heaven (John 6)
Prophet, Priest, and King (Deuteronomy 18:15, Psalm 99:6, Deuteronomy 33:5)	Prophet, Priest, and King (Acts 3:22-26, Hebrews 9:11, Revelation 19)
Fasted 40 days (Exodus 24:18)	Fasted 40 days (Mark 1:13)
Gave them water from the rock (Exodus 17)	Gave them water from the Rock (John 7:37-40)

The Prophet Like Moses

Mediator of the Old Testament (Hebrews 8:1-6)	Mediator of the New Testament (Hebrews 8:1-6)
Performed signs, wonders, and miracles (Exodus)	Performed signs, wonders, and miracles (4 Gospels)
Offered to die for the sins of his people (Exodus 32:20-33)	Offered to die for the sins of his people (1 Corinthians 15)
The Law given 50 days after the Passover	The Holy Spirit given 50 days after the Passover
Face shone with the glory of God from the mountain (Exodus 34)	Face shone with the glory of God from the mountain (Matthew 17:2)
Resurrected bodily and ascended into heaven (Jude 1)	Resurrected bodily and ascended into heaven (Matthew 28)
Interceded for the people (Exodus – Deuteronomy)	Interceded for the people (Hebrews 7:25)
Built a dwelling place for God (the tabernacle) (Exodus)	Built a dwelling place for God (the church) (Ephesians 2:20-22)
