

PSALM 25**Psalm 25**

(2-3) Compare with Isaiah 49:22-23, Romans 10:11, Romans 9:32-33, Isaiah 28:16 and Joel 2:26-27

Transgress without a cause (see Psalm 19:13, Romans 6:14) On Presumptuous Sin (Numbers 15:30-31)

(4-5) Are you asking God to show you his ways and for him to teach you his paths? (John 14:26, 15:7-14) And we know what the wisdom of the Holy Ghost is (1 Corinthians 2:9-14). What are spiritual things? (John 6:63 and Romans 7:14) After comparing Scripture with Scripture you are to rightly divide it (2 Timothy 2:15)

Also, God teaches gradually and here a little and there a little (Isaiah 28:9-13)

(8) Good and upright is the Lord: **THEREFORE** will he teach sinners in the way.

(9) If you are meek (humble), he will guide in judgment and teach his ways to that man

You have to humble to be teachable! (James 4:6)

(12) A man that fears the Lord, **HIM** shall God teach *in the way that he shall choose*. God teaches everybody his way in different ways. (Make reference to that hymn *God leads us along* (298) – some through the water, flood, fire, all through the blood) Discuss this. IMPORTANT: If you deviate all at all from this book you are going astray (thy word is truth). This verse does not teach many ways to God, like many religions. Rather the verse plainly states that God shall teach a man in the way that God chooses. Some suffer much, others don't. But it is all the goodness of God that leadeth a man to repentance.

(14) God reveals his secret to those that fear him.
