

Worship the LORD

Worship the LORD in the beauty of holiness (Psalm 29:2)
O Come and let us worship and bow down before the LORD (Psalm 95:6)

Genesis 22:5 (first mention) The first time worshipping the LORD appears in the Bible is found in the story of the sacrifice of Isaac, which is a type of the shed blood of Christ.

Genesis 4:1-7 Compare Abel's sacrifice with Cain's.
Right Faith + Right Sacrifice = Accepted : Right Faith + Wrong Sacrifice = Not Accepted
The blood of a lamb (!) mingled with the right faith is acceptable to the LORD!
Hallelujah! Do you have the right faith? Is it mingled with the blood of THE LAMB?
Imagine that, the Lord shows us from the beginning the blood of a lamb mingled with faith makes you acceptable in the sight of God! You know what happened when you were born again, you were made acceptable in the beloved (Ephesians 1:6).

John 4:22-24 The Father desires worship that is in spirit and in truth. True worshippers worship God in spirit and in truth. That is the criteria. If you are contrary to the truth, and you know it, you cannot worship the Lord – your worship is vain. When you worship the Lord it must be in spirit and in truth. (Philippians 3:3, Romans 10:1-4)
*Worship is connected to believing all things in the Book: Acts 24:14-15

When the LORD shows up we ought to worship him: Exodus 33:1-10
*Because you cannot take for granted the Lord showing up (Read Revelation 1-3). The Lord warns the churches if they don't repent and get right he would remove their churches (Revelation 2:5)

Ways in which you can worship the LORD

שָׁכַח The word for worship in the Hebrew tongue. It means to depress, to prostrate (lying stretched out on the ground with one's face towards the ground; to bow down, fall down flat (AMEN!))

Falling Flat on your face before the LORD and Bowing Down
